- 1. Applications for the selection test for the above study programme conducted by the Department of Legal Studies of the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences will be available from 10th November 2022 to 10th December 2022.
- 2. A person aged 18 years or above who has acquired any of the following educational/ professional qualifications is eligible to apply for this programme.
 - i. Have three (03) passes from any three subjects at one and the same sitting at the G.C.E. (A/L) Examination in Sri Lanka in any stream, or
 - ii. Have four (04) passes at the G.C.E. (A/L) Examination (under the old syllabus, which has four (04) subjects), of which at least three (03) passes should have been obtained at one and the same sitting in any stream, or
 - iii. Have thirty (30) course credits at SLQF level 2 or above from any Programme offered by the Open University of Sri Lanka, or
 - iv. Attorneys-at-Law of the Supreme Court of Sri Lanka may seek direct entry into Level 4 of the programme, and they will be exempted from the selection test and Level 3 of the programme. They are required to register in the academic year 2022/2023 along with the other selected students. However, the academic activities for Level 4 under the new curriculum will be commenced on 2023/2024 academic year. Therefore, Attorneys should wait until 2023/2024 academic year to start their studies,

AND

- v. Have an equivalent or higher qualification acceptable to the Senate.
 - * Selection Test admissions are available to download from 12th December 2022 to 8th January 2023. IT Help Desk will send a link to download via both SMS and emails to all applicants who have payment done. Admissions will be processed after closing the application.
- 3. Selection to the programme will be made on the basis of performance at the competitive Selection Test. Selection Test will be held on 08th January 2023.
- 4. The applications will be available online only and the applicants shall be solely responsible for the filling and submission of the online application. Under no circumstance university will accept paper applications.
- 5. Candidates must clearly indicate in the application the Regional Centre in which they wish to follow the academic activities. Under no circumstances will a registered student be permitted to change the Regional Centre selected by him/her after enrollment or during the programme.
 - i. Candidates must select the Regional Centre located closest to her/his permanent residency.
 - ii. At the time of registration, the selected candidates must submit a copy of Electoral Register certified by Gramasewa Niladhari and authenticated by Divisional Secretary/ District Secretary to prove the permanent residency status.
 - iii. The submission of copies of Electoral Register certified by Gramasewa Niladhari authenticated by Divisional Secretary/District Secretary is a compulsory requirement for enrolment without which no selected candidates shall be enrolled in the programme.
 - iv. Candidates must sit the Selection Test at the particular Regional Centre mentioned by them in the application form to follow the study programme.
